4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion	If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately wash out mouth with water. Seek urgent medical attention.
Eye	If in eyes, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor.
Skin	If skin contact occurs, Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
Inhaled	Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If symptoms persist, contact doctor / physician.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Clean Up	Spills will be slippery so treat promptly. For minor spills mop up and rinse with water. For larger spills absorb material on mineral absorbent material or absorbent pads. Handling	Adjust nozzle of trigger spray to give a coarse spray to prevent misting. Spray at arm's length directly onto stained area. Wash hands after use.
Storage	Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place out of direct sunlight.
